



Eagan Hockey Association 2011-2012 Fundraising Raffle Details

Eagan Hockey Association will again hold a raffle for their Fundraising event for the 2011-2011 season. Due to the nature of our organization, fundraising is a necessary effort among all of our families to continue to maintain reasonable and competitive fees while providing our members with adequate ice time and developmental instruction. We believe our raffle event simplifies the fundraising process while also providing the opportunity to win a cash prize outlay. Each EHA player will be responsible for selling a number of tickets eligible for a variety of cash prizes.

- ◆ Tickets are \$5 a ticket. Each EHA player is required to sell/buy \$150 worth or 30 tickets for their fundraising obligation.
- ◆ At the time of ticket distribution, each EHA player will receive 30 tickets. A waiver form will also be signed at this time directing responsibility in case of any lost or stolen tickets. Please see attached pages regarding this policy.
- ◆ If the player does not sell all 30 tickets, the remaining amount of unsold tickets automatically becomes the "buy-out" amount to be paid to EHA. It is each EHA players fundraising obligation to contribute \$150 to the fundraising raffle this year, whether that be by selling \$150 worth of tickets or forfeiting the ticket sales and contributing \$150 cash to the Association. Please see example below for further clarification.

Ie. Player sells 20 tickets @ \$5 for a total of \$100. The remaining buy-out becomes \$50 for the required total of \$150. The remaining 10 tickets will have the player's family listed as the designated ticket owner for the tickets and will be entered in the raffle as such.

- ◆ A player can choose not to sell any of the raffle tickets, but they are still responsible for the mandatory \$150 obligation. The tickets will list the player's family as the designated ticket owner.
- ◆ There will be a grand cash prize for the raffle valued at \$1450, 2nd place is \$1000 cash, 3rd place is \$500 cash. 25 additional cash awards will also be offered. A listing of the cash prizes to be given away is available upon request from the EHA Fundraising Coordinator.
- ◆ Fundraising Coordinators will be given spreadsheets for their team with the ticket numbers listed and the players' names for tracking purposes. If any errors are noted or changes need to be made, please notify the Fundraising Coordinator as soon as possible.

- ◆ Additional tickets are available to sell. These additional tickets will need to be requested from your team fundraising representative. The same rules apply here and the tickets will be available in \$25 increments or 5 ticket packets. Unsold additional tickets will NOT be returnable to EHA. They must all be purchased by the player/family or sold.

Important Raffle Dates:

- *November 20th - Fundraising meetings & Ticket distribution
- *November 20th–January 15th – Ticket selling period
- *January 16th – Ticket stubs & money to be turned in
- *January 22rd – Raffle Drawing
- *January 23th – Winners announced at EHA Fundraising Dinner at Green Mill in Eagan

Policy / Waiver on Lost Tickets & Money

- ◆ Ticket stub is lost or stolen:
 - Fundraising Coordinator must be notified immediately
 - Lost or stolen ticket #'s must be reported
 - Ticket # will be voided and will be replaced with new ticket #

- ◆ Ticket stub is lost or stolen but money is turned in for it:
 - Fundraising Coordinator must be notified immediately
 - Lost or stolen ticket #'s must be reported
 - Ticket # will be voided and will be replaced with new ticket #

- ◆ Ticket Money is lost or stolen
 - Fundraising Coordinator must be notified immediately
 - Ticket #'s will be left as is since buyer paid for that ticket and the money owed will become the responsibility of the seller. (Per policy in previous years, lost sales dollars are the sellers' responsibility to repay to the Association.)
 - The seller will turn in \$150 at the end of the selling period, regardless of any ticket money that is lost or stolen during said selling period.

Waiver

I, _____ agree to be held responsible for these tickets and the subsequent dollars attributed to the sale of them. I will exercise caution and care in their maintenance and distribution in order to prevent loss or theft of them. If there is any loss of a ticket or money, I will pay the difference as my buy-out option to the Eagan Hockey Association fundraising raffle, not to exceed \$150 or the amount of any additional tickets I may receive.
